Clerk's Report – October 2022

Early Voting

Preparations with the Lake County Clerk are underway for Avon Township to once again be a host site for early voting. Early voting will be held in the William "Bill" McNeill Community Room. Signs go up later this month and the community room will be closed from October 26th until November 8th. A friendly second reminder that the November meeting has been moved to November 15th to accommodate the election.

My office has responded to seven constituents who needed clarification of the new Permanent Vote by Mail letters that were sent by the Lake County Clerk's office over the past two weeks. I am happy to see that voters are engaged and wanting to make sure they register properly for this new program.

FOIA Update

My office has responded to three new FOIA requests totaling 224 pages and taking 7 hours to complete with an average response time of three days. For the past 12 months there have been 26 requests in total, 1275 pages delivered, 34 hours of processing time with an average turnaround of 4.8 days. This response time includes nine requests that were extended due to voluminous or commercial requests.

2022 Tax Year Levy

Enclosed you will find a copy of the 2021 Tax Levy, PTAX report and a listing of predominant rates provided by the Lake County Clerk's office in preparation for the tax levy process. An update from the Lake County Clerk's office regarding new processes, timelines and key dates is below.

As of January 01, 2022, certification to the county clerk, including any supplemental or supportive documentation, may be submitted electronically (Public Act 102-0625 (SB1667)). Unless otherwise directed, the County Clerk's office will return filings digitally stamped along with a filing receipt via email only. Upon request, we can also mail you a hard copy of the filing receipt. If you wish to have paper copies of the documents date-stamped, they must be provided to us (in-person or mailed) with a self-addressed, stamped envelope.

For tax year 2022 (collectable in 2023), taxing districts must submit their levies to the County Clerk's office on or before Tuesday, December 27, 2022. For your planning purposes, the Lake County Clerk's office will be closed on Friday, December 23 and Monday, December 26, 2022, and we ask that your district plan accordingly.

Supplemental is advice from TOI which states, "Truth in Taxation must be determined no later than December 6th and a truth In Taxation Hearing, if required, must be held no later than December 20th.

It is my recommendation that the Board settle on a determination of the levy no later than the November 15th Regular Meeting so that the hearing process (if necessary) and levy adoption can be completed at the December meeting and we avoid having to reconvene over the holidays.

Proclamation Honoring Manitou Creek

Included in the packet is a proclamation I helped put together honoring the work of the Manitou Creek Drainage District and their efforts to rename the once ill-named creek. I believe it is fitting and proper that we acknowledge this important social justice work in our own community and honor this occasion the day after Indigenous Peoples Day. I have enclosed some newspaper articles about the efforts of the members of the district for your reference.

Hurtful to inspiring

Deemed offensive to Native Americans, Lake County creek r

After a yearlong effort by county officials, the name of a Lake County creek has gone from hurtful to Native

Americans to inspiring.

Meandering from Fox Lake through Ingleside and the Round Lake area down toward Mundelein, the 15-mile Squaw Creek is now officially Manitou Creek.

While "squaw" is considered a derogatory ethnic and sexual slur against Native American women, "manitou" represents the spirit of the stream and the lifeblood of the region's

Indigenous people.

Jim Denomie, a citizen of the Bad River Chippewa Tribe, pointed out the offensive nature of the original creek name when he first became a board member of one of Lake County's drainage districts. That district is named after the creek. It, too, now has a new name: Manitou Creek Drainage District

"It took a little longer than I would have liked it to take, but it didn't bother me," said Denomie, who lives in Hainesville with his wife, Barb, part of the sovereign nation of the Menominee Tribe of Wisconsin.

"We made it. ... It's a victory."

Changing the name, which dated back to 1840, required approval from the U.S. Board on Geographic Names.

The effort evolved into a communitywide campaign, with residents, organizations, elected officials, volunteers and other Lake County leaders stepping forward to support members of the drainage district.

More than 35 letters of support accompanied the name change application, said Patrick Duby, president of the three-person board of the Manitou

Creek Drainage District.

As part of the federal application process, a period of time allows people to either support or oppose the effort.

"We weren't going to leave it to chance," Duby said. "We decided we're going to get all the support ahead. They said we were one of the most complete cases that had been filed. We were really excited. The outpouring of support has been fantastic."

Duby remembers when Denomie first pulled him aside more than a year ago to suggest the name change.

"This is something we should do something about." Duby immediately

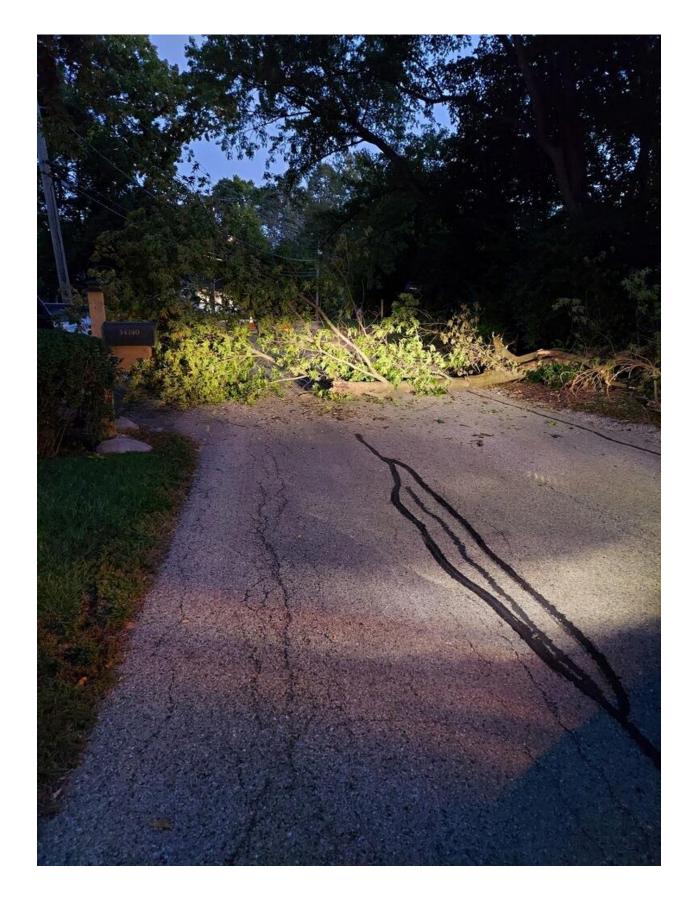

- All bank accounts have been reconciled through September 30, 2022 with the exception of the Wealth Management accounts which will be available later this week.
- ONB resumed the charging of monthly fees effective in August. See Finance Packet Item# 3.d. for further analysis.
- 3. We have collected 90% of the Property Tax Distributions from Lake County fiscal year to date in accordance with the schedule provided. The next scheduled receipt date is 10/20/22. The portion of the levy relating to the PTAB/COE 2020 Special Distribution is being shared by the Town and Road & Bridge Funds as agreed upon by our independent auditors.
- 4. Grant monies received by the Township has been updated in a worksheet included in this month's finance packet as requested Item# 4.b. The Township received no new grant money this month.
- 5. Cash donations designated specifically to support the Avon Township Food Pantry is being tracked in the Finance Packet Item# 4.c. One donation was received in September.
- 6. The work has begun on the construction of the outside classroom. Included in the Finance Packet Item# 4.d. is a schedule that outlines the spending incurred to date. Next week a reimbursement request will be submitted to the Mainstreet Organizations of Realtors for the spending to date. Contact has been made with the organization and they have conveyed that the project and all spending requests need to be received by 12/1/22. In order to receive the maximum Grant Award of \$20K, the project must be completed by this timeframe.

Honoring The Manitou Creek Drainage District For Their Work To Correct A Historically Derogatory Name

WHEREAS, the Manitou Creek Drainage District is an appointed body responsible for the stewardship of the Manitou Creek Watershed that runs through Fremont, Grant and Avon Townships; and

WHEREAS, Avon Township is a land historically stewarded by the Kilikaapoi, Peoria, Bodewadmi, Myaamia, Ochethi Sakowin and Hoocak indigenous people; and

WHEREAS, the former and historical name of the creek, established in 1840, used the word "squaw", which referred to an ethic and sexual slur against indigenous women; and

WHEREAS, the Manitou Creek Drainage District of Lake County, including Patrick Duby, James DeNomie and Jeri Sauner, recognized the harmful nature of the historical name; and

WHEREAS, the members of the Manitou Creek Drainage District worked diligently to gather local, state and federal support to correct the name in a fashion that honors and preserves the indigenous roots of the name of the creek while erasing the stigma of the prior name; and

WHEREAS, the members of the committee continue their work to steward the land by preserving the wildlife of the region through no-kill policies and in a spirit that honors the land.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Michele Bauman, Supervisor of Avon Township, Lake County, Illinois, do hereby recognize and proclaim October 11, 2022 as "Manitou Creek Day" in Avon Township.
